Rules & Regulations

General Rules and regulations:

1. The Registration amount (Rs.200 per student) and accommodation fee (Rs.750 per student for outstation participants) should be sent along with the hard copy of registration form to St. Xavier's College, Jaipur latest by 31st Dec. 2013.
2. The above mention amount should be sent through cheque/DD in favour of **St. Xavier's College, Jaipur**.
3. An official letter from the college authority is necessary which should include the names of the students participating. It should mention the name of the contingent leader, who will be in contact with our Organizing Committee – Registrations.
4. Each participant/visitor must carry their college ID Cards for registrations. Students/participants without ID cards will not be allowed in the college.
5. Three entries per college are allowed for all the events except **The Thespian Art, Katha-Vyatha-Kavita (Nukkad Natak) and RangManch**, where only two entries per college are allowed.
6. Admission in college premises will only be through ZEST 2014 badge which will be given on the day of the event at the time of registration.
7. This Badge validates entry on both the days of the event i.e.11th and12th January 2014.
8. Please do not carry beverages with alcoholic content, sharp objects, inflammable objects, and/or any other object that is potentially dangerous.
9. Any misbehavior on part of the participants and visitors will lead to expulsion from the college premises and reflect on their college.
10. Anything that can be perceived as being offensive to any national and religious sentiments and gender will lead to immediate disqualification.
11. All rights to admission are reserved by the college administration.
12. There can be an elimination for certain events if the number of entries exceed maximum number.

Scoring Scheme

- The winning team of every event will get 5 points.
- The runners up will get 3 points.
- And the team scoring the *third* position will get 2 points.
- For participation 1 point will be awarded.
- (-1) for not turning up for the event registered.
- A trophy will be awarded to the best college overall and outstation after accumulation of all the points.
- Cash prize will be awarded to the winners of the **flagship** events i.e. Life-o-Graphitty, The Thespian Art, and Breakaway.

RULES FOR ACCOMMODATION:

- Accommodation for the participants will be provided outside the college (at walking distance).
- Rooms will be provided on four people sharing basis
- Accommodation charges would be **Rs.750** per student for **3 days** which include breakfast and lunch but excluding participation fee i.e. **Rs.200** per student.
- Breakfast and lunch will be provided at college campus.
