- Band shall get 15 minutes on stage (including sound check). Exceeding the time limit shall lead to deduction of points.
- The band has to perform at least one instrumental jamming in the time allotted.
- All songs played must have instrumental accompaniment.
- No karaoke or pre-recorded music shall be allowed. If found so, that shall lead to disqualification.
- The participants are requested to get their own instruments. The host college shall provide the team with the drum set only (if required).

Direct finals. All participants should be pre-registered.

Performances shall be judged on clarity of rendition, on sense, scale and voice clarity.

Scope of Questions: Questions shall be asked from the following areas

- Fine Arts (Literature, Paintings and Crafts, Music and Films)
- Geography
- General Science
- Current Affairs
- Indian Polity
- Indian Culture Heritage and History
- Current Affairs in Indian Business

Elimination Round

- Each team would be given a set of question papers containing 25 objective type questions.
- Time limit 20 minutes.
- Only 7 Teams would be selected for Stage rounds.
- In case of tie between 2 or more teams, further 3 questions shall be asked for final selection.

Stage Rounds

First Round

• Each team shall be asked 5 questions (from specialized area opted by the team)

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- 10 marks for correct answer, and no negative marking for wrong answer.
- Only 6 teams would be selected for the second round.
- Each team shall be given 30 seconds to reply to each question.

Second Round

- This round shall be a **buzzer round**.
- 10 marks shall be added for the correct answer and 5 marks shall be deducted for the wrong answer or no answer (if the team presses the buzzer).
- Only 4 teams would be selected for the last round.
- Each team shall be given 30 seconds to reply to each question.

Third Round

- This Round would be an audio-visual round.
- 10 marks shall be added for the correct answer and 5 marks shall be deducted for the wrong answer.
- Each Team would be asked 2 audio-visual questions.
- Each team shall be given 30 seconds to reply.
- If a team fails to answer the question, then the question shall be forwarded to the next team.

Take the dance floor by storm with your passion, vigour, excitement, spontaneity and unleash the colours of youth within you.

The young stars who are hoping to participate in Break - away 2014 are expected to present minimum one of the following dance forms Bollywood, Contemporary, Hip-hop.

- Each team has to prepare a dance sequence of 8-10 minutes including setup up time. There shall be negative marking for exceeding the time limit.
- Teams can have a minimum of 2 and maximum of 12 participants.
- Only 3 entries per college are allowed.
- The use of properties (props, if any) shall be arranged by the participants themselves. Use of harmful props like, lighted candles, matchsticks, cigarettes etc. is not allowed and shall lead to disqualification. It may also be noted that the dance floor area must be in the same condition after the performances as before.
- Teams are expected to portray the theme (Heroes v/s Villains) through dance and choreography.
- The costumes should be according to the dance form and choreography. Decency in the performance or act should be kept in mind at all times.

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- Teams must bring 2 CDs (1 audio CD and 1 .mp3 CD) and a pen-drive containing their sound track. One CD is to be submitted at the time of registrations.
- Each participant should carry their college identity cards at the time of registrations.
- The teams must duly note that the name of the college/institute should not be presented at the time of the performance.
- Obscenity of any form shall lead to disqualification.


Direct finals. All participants should be pre-registered

The entries should duly note that the choreography, selection of music and costumes should be modest.

Nukkad Natak is a branch of theatre which reaches out to social masses in an effective way. Katha-Vyatha-Kavita is an opportunity for the educated youth to bring awareness amongst its fraternity and to other classes of society towards evil social practices and their eradication. Let's come together and try to be the change we wish to see in our society.

- The theme for Nukkad Natak is social issues. There shall be negative marking if there is no link between the theme and the performance.
- 2 teams per college are allowed.
- A warning bell shall ring after 13 minutes
- Any kind of remarks on college and university shall lead to immediate disqualification.
- Points shall be deducted for vulgarity in language and presentation.
- Scripts should be original/self -written.
- Teams must arrive at the venue 45 minutes before the event commences.
- No microphones, speakers, music systems will be allowed or available. Teams can sing / dance by themselves to create the necessary music or sound.
- Teams must bring all their requirements and must be ready well in time as per instructions of the organizer. No props or costume or any material will be provided by the host college
- Decision of Judges will be final and binding on all teams.
- The performance shall be judged on Creativity & Innovation, Clarity of Message/Theme, Props, Costume/Dressing, Team Work.

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Life-O-Graphitty, an event for the youth who see life and its several colours through their camera lenses. It is a vehicle for creative self-expression.

Documentary film making is a braver way to make films because it's real and one is a witness to the happenings around. What is great about documentary film making is that it can be experimental film making. One has the liberty of doing diverse things under the ambit of 'Documentary'.

Now is the chance, to build up the passion for portraying real life through 'reel life'.

This event is about capturing inside the world of fest i.e., ZEST 2014, in your own creative ways wherein you can create your own stories, add effects, animate, interact, shoot and thus bringing up a message.

Glimpse

- All films, all works of art for that matter, start in the same place: with an idea.
- Look at everything and determine what is relevant.
- How influential is the event that is being captured?
- The documentary should be in accordance to the theme.
- Focus only on what's important and that can be captured perfectly.
- The best films of any kind, narrative or documentary should provoke questions.

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Rules:

General Rules

To create the movie, please follow these guidelines:

- The movie must be shot and edited only during the prescribed time.
- The movie must follow prescribed event guidelines as posted at the time of the submission.
- The event does not assume responsibility for technical, electronic, network, computer hardware or software failure of any kind, stolen, incomplete, garbled, late, misdirected, damaged, illegal, misaddressed entries, incorrectly transmitted entries, or any other entry which does not meet the requirements set out in rule.
- The panel of judges and the organizers reserves the right to eliminate any entry on the basis of objectionable content, including but not limited to nudity or illegal imagery or actions.
- The decisions of the judges will be final in all respects.

Round One:

- Elimination round: The participants are requested to send a short-film of 5-8 minutes, keeping "Youth" as its theme, with a title and the name of the team members. **Three** entries per college are allowed. The last date for sending in the entries is 25th December, 2013.
- Only 8 entries will qualify for the final round if the registration limit exceeds wherein each team has to make a documentary of both the days of the fest-Zest 2014.

Round Two:

- Being a flagship event it holds a cash prize.
- One team should have not more than 3-4 participants.
- Students are supposed to bring their own equipments.

- The teams have to cover at least four to five events of the fest.
- The time limit of each documentary should not exceed more than 5-7 minutes.
- Adherence to the theme counts 20% in judging.
- Students will be allowed an additional five minutes to set and five minutes to remove equipment's.
- The teams can add photos, videos, animations, inside and outside interviews, etc.
- During the 'Life-O-Graphitty' event, team will be asked to send their talking heads (representative who will explain the documentary to the judges) to present their documentary.
- After the presentation, there will be a question round wherein judges can ask questions.

Judging criteria

The movies will be judged on the following criteria, with equal weightage.

• Content

Script/story, creativity, originality,

coherence

• Technical excellence

Visual creativity, cinematography, sound design and sound track, editing, effective use of special effects.

• Overall quality

Overall impression, decency, entertainment factor, meaningfulness, replay value.

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Sing it solo, sing it loud, Ease your vocals and freeze the crowd, Set the tone by practicing your pitch, Clear your vocal cords and start to sing.

Participants trained in vocals are invited to compete in the solo singing competiton and sway the audience off thier feet. Let's see how many of us "pitch" in to give you company!!

- Max 3 entries per college.
- Only ONE instrumentalists shall be allowed to accompany the participant. (If he/she wishes to have one.)
- Accompanying instrumentalists are requested to get their own instruments.
- Instrumentalists who may accompany the participant shall not be judged, the participant shall be judged based on his/her performance alone.
- Usage of inappropriate words will lead to disqualification.

Participants will be judged under different criterion based on their performance including clarity of rendition, knowledge of respective raga, sense, scale and clarity.

Improvisations like alaap will be given due merit.

Direct Finals

Participants must be pre-registered. On-the-spot entries will be allowed depending upon the number of pre-registered participants.

The instrumentalist (if any) who shall be accompanying the participant needs to be registered.

All the participants will be provided by a brief description of a mystic creature and they are required to illustrate the character using their our imagination while sticking to the brief.

Please note that poster colours or any other water based colours will non be permitted apart from the ones mentioned. The judging criterion for the event is relevance to the brief, originality, creativity, use of medium and use of space.

- There will be a warning bell after 15 minutes and final bell after 20 minutes. In case the act exceeds the time limit, there will be negative marking.
- Participants have to get their own props. We will not provide any assistance regarding the props.
- Points will be deducted for vulgarity.
- The theme of the act should be in tandem with the theme of the competition. The theme of 'RangManch' is 'The numerous shades of youth'.
- The participants should opt for a suitable dress code.
- The decision of Judges will be final and binding. The organizing committee reserves the right to change the time, venue and rules, if desired.

- After each presentation there will be a question and answer round, which will be opened for judges and participating teams.
- Please note that the language of the presentation should be decent, any sort of obscenity shall lead to disqualification.
- Time criteria for act/play/presentation- 5 mins. + 1 mins. for judges in traction
- no materials for ad making or presentation will be provided by the hosting college. Participants should get their own materials as required. (eg. laptops, pendrive)

Direct finals

Participants will be judged on Innovation, creativity, originality, clarity, relevance of ideas, presentation.

- Any kind of remarks on college and university will lead to immediate disqualification
- Leaving the stage empty for more than 30 seconds in between the sequences will result in elimination.
- Pre-recorded music, musical instruments and background scores are permitted.
- Points will be deducted for obscenity.
- No props will be provided by the coordinators.
- Decision of judges will be final and binding on all teams.

The performance shall be judged on Creativity & Innovation, Clarity of Message/Theme, Props, Costume/Dressing, Team Work.

- The jury will select the top members from each group and they will qualify for the final round of JAM.
- The decision of the jury will be final and binding.

Finals

- The contestant is then given one minute by the moderator to speak on the topic. Marks will be deducted for exceeding the time limit.

Final round (extempore).

Selected participants will be given a topic on the moment and they will be given 1 min 30 seconds to speak on the topic.

Winners will be selected on the basis of cumulative scores of the first and second round.

Participants will be judged on spontaneity, grammar, content, eloquence.

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- An official letter from the college authority is necessary which should include the names of the students participating. It should mention the name of the contingent leader, who will be in contact with our organizing committee registrations.
- Each participant/visitor must carry their college ID Cards for registrations. Students/participants without ID cards should get Bonafide made by their college or fee receipt along with government authorised I.D. Card
- One Contingent entry and two P.R.N.C. (Pre Registered Non Contingent) per college are allowed for all the events except The Thespian Art, Katha-Vyatha-Kavita (Nukkad Natak) and RangManch where only two entries per events are allowed.
- Points for P.R.N.C. teams will not be Counted for over all points of the college.
- Admission in college premises will only be through ZEST 2014 badge which will be given on the day of the event at the Time of registration.
- This Badge validates entry on both the days of the event i.e.11th and12th January 2014.
- Please do not carry sharp objects, inflammable objects, and/or any other object that is potentially dangerous.
- Please do not carry any beverages with alcoholic content.
- Any misbehavior on part of the participants and visitors will lead to expulsion from the college premises and reflect on their college.
- Anything that can be perceived as being offensive to any national and religious sentiments and gender will lead to immediate disqualification.
- All rights to admission are reserved by the college administration.
- There can be an elimination for certain events if the number of entries exceed maximum number.

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- The winning team of every event will get 5 points.
- The runners up will get 3 points.
- And the team scoring the third position will get 2 points.
- For participation 1 point will be awarded.
- (-1) for not turning up for the event registered.
- A trophy will be awarded to the best college overall and outstation after accumulation of all the points.
- Cash prize will be awarded to the winners of the flagship events i.e. Life-o-Graphitty, The Thespian Art, Breakaway and Battle of the Decibels.
