GENERAL GUIDELINES

- There can only be one contingent per event from a college.
- Entry to the campus will not be allowed after 5:30 pm sharp everyday.
- Participants for the offline events have to reach the college campus by 8:30 am.
- Please check the closing dates for registration for different events having online elimination as per the deadline (if not met).
- The online events will take place on online platforms Zoom and Google Meet and the offline/on-campus events will take place at their designated venues in the campus.
- The participants have to arrange their laptops, cameras, and other materials required in various events and ensure they have a working Internet connection.
- Participants/visitors with online registration will have to show the soft copy of the email of confirmation of registration, along with their Aadhar card.
- Any misbehavior on the part of the participants and visitors will lead to immediate expulsion from the event and no further discussion on this will be entertained. Anything that can be perceived as being offensive to national/religious/communal/gender sentiments etc. will lead to immediate disqualifications.
- Any issues arising due to technical/connectivity glitches will not be the responsibility of the Event Coordinators or Team Zest.
- Judges' decisions shall stand as final and binding to all, in each competition.
- If any discrepancy arises, the decision of the Students' Council shall be binding.
- Team Zest has the full and sole discretionary powers of expelling participants on the grounds of indiscipline, misbehavior, or any other inappropriate activities.

(GROUP DANCE)

It's Dance O'clock!

Zest '23 presents a group dance event which will be premised on western and classical motifs. We are thrilled to be back with another edition of the event to take you away from the shackles and inspire others.

So once again, buckle up and get your groups set for incredible skills and performances because Shake It Up will astonish you!

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- This is a team event.
- All dance forms are permitted.
- This event consists of 3 rounds.
- The size of the teams can be 7 to 20 members.
- The maximum number of participants from each group on-screen allowed is 15 members. This is not applicable in round three.
- Only 2 volunteers are allowed per team, excluding the team instructor/ non-performer choreographer (if any).
- Exceeding the number of participants and volunteers will lead to disqualification.
- The dance performance should not convey any indecent gestures.
- The performance should be time-bound.
- Teams have to report on the time given or else they will be disqualified.
- The decision of the judges will be conclusive and binding.
- The use of flammable items is strictly prohibited.

Round 1: Online Round

- Teams must send a dance video of three to four minutes at groupdance.zest23@gmail.com latest by 27th January 2023
- The video size should not be more than 20 MB.
- The mail must include the contact details of the appropriate person to coordinate with.
- Sending an edited video will lead to negative markings.

Round 2: Showcase Round

- Songs can be selected as per the preference of the team.
- The selected participants from the First Round will have to mail their tracks by 30th January 2023.
- Voiceover and fusion music are allowed.
- Costumes are not obligatory for this round.
- Vulgarity and obscenity at any point are strictly prohibited. It will lead to immediate disqualification.
- All the participants in the video must be present during the actual performance.
- This round will be conducted offline.
- All the selected teams from Round 1 have to perform the same extended performance sent for the elimination round through video.
- This performance will be judged again with various criteria.
- The time limit for the performance is 6 to 8 minutes.
- No team will be allowed to change their tracks or team members.
- The selected teams will be allotted a green room in this round.
- All the other rules of the elimination round will be followed in this round too.

Round 3: Prop Round

- 7 dancers from each team will be present on stage for this round.
- Song (1 minute 30 seconds to 2 minutes) will be assigned to each team 15 minutes prior to this round.
- Organizers will provide songs and props to the teams.
- Props will be decided through 'lots' at the end of Round 2.
- The prop assigned should be used in respective dance performances otherwise it will lead to disqualification of the team.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- All rounds are elimination rounds.
- Vulgarity or indecent gestures at any point of the performance will lead to disqualification.
